Program will be composed of excursions focused on plants and animals, but also **individual simple ecological projects**. I will lead the excursion with **Petr Blažek**, and we will have in the team also a zoologist. **Ecological projects will be focused both on plants and animals. Suggestions on projects are welcome.**

Projects should collect some data, which will be analysed, and we will arrange for some evening session in October or November, where individual groups will present their results on a rather informal seminar.



The course will start on Sunday September 10 at the station (or by common departure from České Budějovice Sunday noon). Return on Friday September 15 afternoon.
